- 2. Scholarship can be used to cover tuition for upcoming educational credits only.
- 3. The institution must be a two or four-year accredited public nonprofit college, university, or vocational/technical school in Utah. Awards will not be made for students attending a for-profit institution.
- 4. The scholarship can be applied to any semester between Fall 2025 and Full 2026.
- 5. Awardees **must write a one page essay on the impact of the scholarship within one semester of the award**. A photo must also be provided.

- 3. Include 2 letters of recommendation from a teacher, employer, religious leader, etc.
