OUR PROGRAMS

Women of the World accomplishes its mission through three programs: Customized Service & Advocacy, Economic Empowerment, and Community Development.

- Teaching Practical and Intensive English using the “classroom of the community” model.
- Ensuring that a clients' immediate health, family, and financial needs are met while encouraging further achievement in academia or industry, to create long-term success.
- Supporting women's daily needs by helping to read mail, advocating with community partners, and facilitating community resources.
- Developing differentiated job skills in language, service, or creative industries that increase their earnings while advocating directly with local employers.
- Giving all displaced women the opportunity of further education through our Displaced Women's Fund.

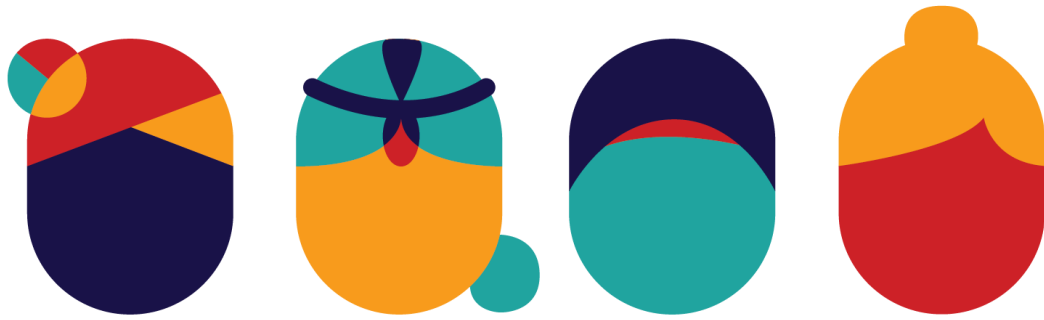
ENABLING SELF-RELIANCE
